

- SUPPLIES NEEDED**
- 3 1/2 YARDS OF 54" WIDE FABRIC
  - SHARP SCISSORS
  - REMOVABLE MARKING MEDIUM (chalk, wax, tailor's tack, etc.)
  - 1 1/2" WIDE IRONING BOARD
  - THREAD
  - SEWING MACHINE
- OPTIONAL:**
- 1/2 YARD OF THINNER POCKET FABRIC
  - FUSIBLE INTERFACING

**CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Print pattern. You can print the document out on sheets of standard size paper and tape the pieces together, or print on a wide-format printer (24" or wider). Print sheets offer this service for approximately \$12. If available to you, the BEST recommendation is large-format printing.

2. Once your pattern is printed, cut along the outermost rectangle to remove any excess paper. This template should fit exactly on a 54" wide or larger piece of fabric that has been folded in half. If your fabric is less than 54" wide, you will need to use two pieces of fabric that have been folded in half and sewed together side-by-side.

3. Fold your fabric in half along the lengthwise grain matching edge to edge. Pin the center of the fold to the center of the fabric. The center marker helps the fabric from stretching or moving. When it is in place, the center of the paper template will align with the center of the fabric. Press the paper template to the top layer of fabric, marking the folded edge of the fabric with the side of the paper marked "folded edge."

4. Pin the paper template to the top layer of fabric, marking the folded edge of the fabric with the side of the paper marked "folded edge."

5. Cut around the perimeter of each piece.

6. Pinning the pieces of fabric, you will need to pin each of the sections, taking care to use only beyond the end of the U-shaped.

7. Mark all pieces with chalk, wax, or other removable marking medium. A tailor's tack may also be used.

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**NOTE A: FABRIC LESS THAN 54" WIDE**

If your fabric is less than 54" wide, you will need to use two pieces of fabric that have been folded in half and sewed together side-by-side. The pieces should be pinned together at the center of the fold. The center of the paper template will align with the center of the fabric. Press the paper template to the top layer of fabric, marking the folded edge of the fabric with the side of the paper marked "folded edge."

**NOTE B: FABRIC WITH FUSIBLE OR DIRECTIONAL PATTERN**

If your fabric has a fusible or directional pattern, you will need to use two pieces of fabric that have been folded in half and sewed together side-by-side. The pieces should be pinned together at the center of the fold. The center of the paper template will align with the center of the fabric. Press the paper template to the top layer of fabric, marking the folded edge of the fabric with the side of the paper marked "folded edge."

**NOTE C: USING FUSIBLE INTERFACING**

Fusible interfacing is used to add strength, stability, and structure to fabric pieces. It is used to reinforce areas of the jumpsuit that will be subjected to stress or strain, such as the pocket flaps, the waistband, and the collar.
