



**JUMPSUIT CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

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**SUPPLIES NEEDED**

- 3/4" YARDS OF 54" WIDE FABRIC
- SHARP SCISSORS
- REMOVABLE MARKING MEDIUM (chalk, wax, tailor's lock, etc.)
- 1/4" NON-SERRATED ZIPPER
- THREAD
- SEWING MACHINE

**OPTIONAL SUPPLIES:**

- 1/2 YARD OF THINNER POCKET FABRIC
- FUSIBLE INTERFACING

**CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Print pattern: You can print this document (that includes our paper grid and trace the pieces together, or print on a scale-diameter printer 1/4" or wider). Please check our site service for approximately \$12. If available to you, the \$20 service includes fabric printing.
2. Once your pattern is printed, cut along the contained rectangle to remove any excess paper. This template should fit exactly on a 34" wide or larger piece of fabric that has been folded in half. If your fabric is less than 34" wide, you may wish to purchase or fabric with a grain differential piece see NOTE B.
3. Fold your fabric in half along the long-edge grain matching selvedge edge to selvedge edge. Selvedge is the self-finished edge of fabric. The grain breaks keep the fabric from stretching or fraying. There is no ridge that would be too fringed, though just in frequency, a clearly finished line will be found. Avoid this edge in your cut pieces or the pattern frequently differs from the main body of the fabric.
4. Place the paper template on top your fabric, matching the folded edge of the fabric with the side of the paper marked "folded edge".
5. Place pins throughout the template pressing together both layers of fabric as well as the paper.
6. Cut around the perimeter of each piece.
7. Leaving the pins in place, you will next need to strip each of the notches, taking care to not strip beyond the end of the 1/4" stripe.
8. **NOTE A:** If you are using a scale-diameter printer, please note that our patterns are designed to be printed on a 34" wide or larger piece of fabric that has been folded in half. If your fabric is less than 34" wide, you may wish to purchase or fabric with a grain differential piece see NOTE B.

**NOTE A: FABRIC LESS THAN 34" WIDE**  
If your fabric is less than 34" wide, you will need to cut with pattern pieces individually from the paper template, and then sew them together to form a continuous piece. This may result in a seam in the middle of the waistband or other end. This does not affect the function or price of the fabric. When marking fabric, please mark the fabric first. Then, use a paper marker to mark the fabric. This does not affect the price of the fabric. You must use the pattern pieces on the fabric. The pattern pieces are designed to be printed on a 34" wide or larger piece of fabric that has been folded in half. If your fabric is less than 34" wide, you may wish to purchase or fabric with a grain differential piece see NOTE B.

**NOTE B: FABRIC WITH GRAIN ON DIFFERENTIAL**  
If your fabric has a grain differential, you may wish to purchase or fabric with a grain differential piece. This does not affect the price of the fabric. You must use the pattern pieces on the fabric. The pattern pieces are designed to be printed on a 34" wide or larger piece of fabric that has been folded in half. If your fabric is less than 34" wide, you may wish to purchase or fabric with a grain differential piece see NOTE B.

**NOTE C: USING FUSIBLE INTERFACING**  
Before interfacings, a small piece of fusible interfacing, including, but not limited to, the waistband, cuffs, and other areas, please use the pattern pieces on the fabric. The pattern pieces are designed to be printed on a 34" wide or larger piece of fabric that has been folded in half. If your fabric is less than 34" wide, you may wish to purchase or fabric with a grain differential piece see NOTE B.

Before cutting your fabric measure this square to make sure that the pattern is scaled correctly\*  
\*using printer and software will automatically add crop and margin which will give you 3"

The inner square should measure 4" x 4"  
The outer square should measure 12cm x 12cm
